<p>2. Position purpose</p>	<p>The head coach will be appointed for a start as soon as possible, the contract is through to the 2024 European Championships in July 2024 with a view to extending.</p>	
<p>3. Main tasks</p>	<p>We are looking for an experienced, European based coach, who is willing to work alongside our assistant coaches and our staff to advance our Women's Field National team program. Short term goal will be the EC 24 in Braga, our long term goal is to have a functional development program for all female players as well as assistance coaches.</p> <p>They coach the Women's NTs in all European and World Championship games. Also they coach the team in preparation tournaments - should they not be able to attend those, they make sure that the coaching staff at the game is instructed and acts within their coaching philosophy. They are expected to lead practices in Switzerland at least once a month.</p> <p>They lead the selection process for NT and development team games and tournaments in consultation with their coaching staff and set the line ups for those games. As part of the selection process, they make sure that the greatest number of players can be included/considered and kept in the selection process in order to grow Women's Lacrosse and to have the most competitive NT possible.</p> <p>They set the practice schedule in consultation with their coaching staff, the GM and possibly the leadership group. They prepare and run the practices themselves or delegate that task to somebody on the coaching staff. This includes not only in-person practices, but also online and video sessions.</p> <p>They set a roadmap prior to every major tournament. The roadmap clarifies the playing philosophy of the NT, when and how many practices and preparation tournaments are being held, what the focus of each practice session should be, which practice sessions will be open practices, which ones will be tryouts, which ones will</p>	

	<p>be closed practices and when cuts are being made. A playbook or something similar is expected to be a part of the roadmap.</p> <p>They hold player-coach meetings in one-on-one settings or groups where expectations for every player are being set and where they define how they make sure they are being met. E.g.: practice attendance, physical preparation, additional work away from the NT like film study, wall ball, additional practice sessions or playbook study.</p> <p>They consult with the team medical personnel for input on additional work away from the NT as well as for selection and line up decisions.</p>
