3. Job Purpose	Goalie Coordinator for Men's Field program, possible assistance with other programs (including Women's Lacrosse) providing goalie training sessions in Switzerland	
4. Primary role	<p>The primary role of the Goalie Coordinator is to develop national team goalies, coach the two primary selections during and in the lead up to the European and World Championship games.</p> <p>The Goalie Coordinator will evaluate all goalie candidates at national team tryouts and provide feedback on goalie selection to the coaching staff. The Goalie Coordinator will then be responsible for creating practice plans for individual goalies to work on, to further develop their skill and lacrosse IQ while allowing the goalie to demonstrate their skill during practices.</p> <p>They are the goalie adviser to the Head Coach on sections for the national team and development team games, in consultation with the other coaching staff. In addition, advising on the starting line up for the goalies for given matches. As part of the selection process, they make sure that the greatest number of players can be included/considered and kept in the selection process to grow the discipline of</p>	

	<p>Field Lacrosse and deliver the most competitive Men's Field NT possible.</p> <p>They are able to attend as many practices/exhibition games as possible to build team cohesion. They will help the Head Coach set the practice schedule in consultation with the other coaching staff, the GM and possibly the leadership group. In consultation with other Coaches and the Head Coach, be able to offer video sessions for off-field coaching.</p> <p>They hold player-coach meetings in coordination with other coaching staff and the Head Coach, where expectations for every player are set and where they define how they make sure they are being met. E.g.: practice attendance, physical preparation, additional work away from the NT like film study, wall ball, additional practice sessions or playbook study.</p> <p>They consult with the team medical personnel for input on additional work away from the NT as well as for selection and line up decisions.</p>
5. Interview process	<p>The candidates for the position will go through a pre-interview with the GM and review of the CV conducted by the Coaching Staff.</p> <p>After the initial cut, some will be asked for a final interview with the Coaching Staff before our preferred candidate is selected for the position.</p>
